Meaning #1	<b>good</b> can mean <i>excellent</i>
	The handmade tablecloth is <i>good</i> . The handmade tablecloth is <i>marvelous</i> .

Meaning #2	<b>good</b> can mean <i>well-behaved</i>
	Thirty <i>good</i> children waited for the movie to begin. Thirty <i>praiseworthy</i> children waited for the movie to begin.

Meaning #3	<b>good</b> can mean <i>skilled</i>
	The electrician was <i>good</i> . The electrician was <i>proficient</i> .

Meaning #4	<b>good</b> can mean <i>useful</i>
	An electric teapot is <i>good</i> . An electric teapot is <i>convenient</i> .

We laughed at the *hilarious* circus act.

**Meaning #2**

**funny** can mean *unusual*

Seeing a house move down the street was *funny*.

Seeing a house move down the street was *bizarre*.
