**Meaning #1**

**cold** can mean *chilly*

On the *cold* day, snow covered the hills.

On the *frigid* day, snow covered the hills.

**Meaning #2**

**cold** can mean *unfriendly*

The *cold* girl walked right past the new students.

The *indifferent* girl walked right past the new students.
