

QUIET (*quiet, more quiet, most quiet*)

Meaning #1	quiet can mean <i>not loud</i>
	<p>The class could not hear Erin's voice because it was so <i>quiet</i>.</p> <p>The class could not hear Erin's voice because it was so <i>soft</i>.</p>

Meaning #2	quiet can mean <i>calm</i>
	<p>Nothing could disturb the <i>quiet</i> Sunday afternoon.</p> <p>Nothing could disturb the <i>tranquil</i> Sunday afternoon.</p>
